



A highlight of the WCCYM year - the WCCYM weekend returns! 48hrs of intense fun, faithfilled conversations and gunge!



St Peter's, Barton - Floor Replacement



On 9th February, PCC members and parishioners from St Peter's, Barton with their vicar, Rev'd Claire, hosted a scrumptious thank you lunch at the village Pavilion for John Boocock, David Hodge and the team of volunteers who recently renovated the church floor.

In June 2024 the quinquennial report on church fabric at St Peter's referenced a need to refurbish the wood block floor at the west end of the nave. The estimated cost was very high, so a group of local volunteers led by John and David agreed to undertake the work for a much lower price. Gifts from locals, sale of signed blocks for the floor, as well as a grant from the Barton Village Trust covered the cost of the work, whilst the volunteers donated their time for free. It was wonderful to see local parishioners joining together to support their community and their church in this way. Many thanks to all those who were involved!
