In July Harlton Church will be celebrating it's 650th anniversary with two very special events, to which everyone is welcome:

## Talk on the History of the Church in Harlton: Wednesday, 2 July at 7pm, Village Hall

As part of this jubilee, Dr Nicholas Branson will give a talk on the history of Harlton Church – the oldest building in the Village. The talk will cover the impact of national events on the life of the church, and it will refer to special features of the building and some of the people associated with the church over the centuries. Some of the church's archives and registers dating back to the beginning of the 19<sup>th</sup> century will be on display. Light refreshments will follow.
