

ALM for Worship Leaders in Rural Contexts

Introduction

The ALM (Authorised Local Ministry) in Worship Leading in Rural Contexts is a local diocesan training pathway for lay people who are called not only to lead worship, but to help shape worship that reaches out, invites in, and supports the mission of the Church within rural communities. This pathway recognises the distinctive opportunities and challenges of rural contexts, where worship often sits at the heart of village life. Participants will explore how worship can become a place of welcome, belonging, and encounter, strengthening connections between church, community, and everyday life.

How will the training be delivered?

Training will begin in April 2026 and will be delivered locally within the Bourn Deanery at the Papworth Team Hub, Pendrill Court and the The Cabin, Hardwick. The course will consist of ten monthly evening study sessions, normally on the first Wednesday of the month between 7.30pm and 9.30pm. The first session will be on **May 4th 2026** at the Papworth Team Hub. Each session will involve learning together through discussion, shared reflection, practical exploration, and mutual encouragement.

Who is the course for?

Lay people from across Bourn Deanery who are already involved in worship, mission and pastoral care or who sense a call to help their church lead missionally through worship in rural contexts. No previous formal training is required – just openness, commitment, and a heart for local mission. Those who complete the pathway may be recommended for Authorisation as an ALM in Worship Leading, serving their local parish and community with the support of clergy and PCC.
